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ABSTRACT

The study was conducted in the municipality of Buguias, Benguet to assess and

inventory possible tourist attractions in the area, assess and identify infrastructure and

services offered, and identify the LGU's plan and development programs in the area.

The results of the study showed that the municipality of Buguias has a number of

tourist attractions in the various barangays. But not all the tourist attractions were validated

and discovered, there is a need for further exploration. The tourist attractions identified are

categorized as either cultural, natural, historical and recreational attractions. All the tourist

attractions are assessed to have a potential market draw of daytrip. Basic transport is

available and the evaluation of surroundings is favourable. Most of the public services are

available except for the ambulance, fire protection, and local banking services. The tourist

attractions need further product development, more identified uses and activities, greater

community participation, better site control and easier access. The local government of

Buguias is recommended to improve the identified tourist attractions and invest in other

tourism-promoting activities. Also the local government unit should come up with a

promotional package for the tourist, and develop brochures and websites to further promote

the various tourist attractions in Buguias.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

List of Tourist Attraction in Barangay Natubleng

The tourist attractions in Barangay Natubleng are identified as follows: the Apo Anno Cave, the Dugen Cave, the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces, the Crocodile Head and Cuyapon Falls. The first three attractions are categorized as cultural attraction while the rest are categorized as natural attractions (See Table 1).

Three of the attractions are found at Nabalicong, wherein the mummy of Apo Anno the legendary hunter of Benguet is found in the Apo Anno Cave; the burial cave of Dugen found at Dugen Cave; and the falls which is said to be the home of Apo Anno's mother that is found at Cuyapon Falls. The two remaining attractions are found at Natubleng, the Apanberang Vegetable Terraces which is most likely a stairways up to the sky, and the Crocodile Head which is a garden that has the shape of a crocodile.

Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Natubleng

The categorized tourist attractions are assessed to their location from central point, ease of access, potential use, environmental fragility, socio-cultural concerns and market draw. All attractions are the same as to potential market draw which is daytrip, majority of them also have the potential disruption on the socio-cultural concerns except for Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces. For the environmental fragility, Apo Anno Cave and Dugen Cave are both nesting area for endangered species, while the Crocodile Head and Cuyapon Falls are both water sources. For the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces there is a possible problem on waste management. Three of the attractions have a high potential use while the other two have medium and low potential uses. Although Cuyapon Falls has a high potential use, the ease of access is difficult not like for the Crocodile Head



which has a low potential use but moderate in ease of access. The closest attractions from the central point, which is the Barangay Hall is the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces

Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attractions in Barangay Natubleng

In inventory evaluation, each of the tourist attractions were ranked as 1-5 wherein (5) is the highest positive rank. The inventory evaluation sheet comprises of the scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities, community participation, site control, access and product development. The total mean rank shows that the highest mean is the most potential tourist attraction in the area. Apo Anno Cave has the highest mean of 3.89. Given all the evaluation areas Apo Anno Cave is ranked 5 in the scenic value and historical value, for the Crocodile Head it is ranked 5 in the scenic value, uses and activities, site control and product development, while for the Cuyapon Falls it is ranked 5



in historical value and for the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces is ranked 5 in product development.

List of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Lengaoan

The tourist attractions in Barangay Lengaoan are identified as follows: Organic Agricultural Learning Center, categorized as a cultural attraction and Sabeng Anito Conservation Park categorized as a natural attraction. (See table 4)

The two attractions are found at Lengaoan. The first attraction is said to be a way of learning organic production of vegetables while for the second attraction it has a small falls that is made for viewing, swimming and a picnic area.

Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Lengaoan

The two attractions are the same as to potential market draw which is daytrip. The Organic Agricultural Learning Center have the land tenure on the socio- cultural concerns while Sabeng Anito Conservation Park have the potential disruption in the socio- cultural concerns. For the environment fragility, Organic Agricultural Learning Center has the possible problem on waste management while Sabeng Anito Conservation Park has environmental fragility on water source. Also, Organic Agricultural Learning Center has a high potential use with a 1 km location from central point while Sabeng Anito Conservation Park has a medium potential use with 7 km location from central point.

Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attractions in Barangay Lengaoan

The Organic Agricultural Learning Center got the highest numerical mean which is 4.56 while Sabeng Anito Conservation Park got a numerical mean of 3.78. The Organic Agricultural Learning Center also ranked 5 on the following: scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities, community participation and product development while Sabeng Anito Conservation Park ranked 5 on the following: scenic value, uses and activities, community participation and product development.

List of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Abatan

Three places identified as tourist attractions were categorized as cultural namely Burial Ground, Vegetable Terraces and Pakedlan. Also, Agno River and Caves were categorized as natural while Marketan, the market place of the people was categorized as historical (See table 7).

The attractions were located in different parts of Abatan and boundary of Loo. Agno River was located in Dagdag which is believed that the river is ideal for all water-based activities like rafting, fishing, canoeing and swimming. Tourists may catch tilapia, carp, eel and other fresh water fishes, provided fishing is done legally. Burial Grounds that are reserved for remain ancestor of the community that is located in Gal-odan, Caves that is still unexplored at Tukok, Garden Terraces at boundary with Loo that is good for viewing, Marketan which is the market place for people that became the beginning of the place which is located at Abatan Proper and Pakedlan, a ritual of the Kankana-ey tribe done when it is needed at Tabbacan.

Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Abatan

All attractions are the same at potential market draw which is daytrip. Both the two tourists attractions, namely; Burial Grounds and Pakedlan have a socio-cultural concerns on land tenure issues and potential disruption while Garden Terraces has a socio-cultural concerns on land tenure issues. Moreover, Agno River and Caves have socio-cultural concerns on potential disruption while Marketan have more concerns on peace and order to community. All have a medium potential use however Marketan have a condition or renovation to work requirement to accommodate visitors. The location and timing varies. The location and timing are as follows: Burial Grounds, once a year; Pakedlan, when it is needed; Garden Terraces, any time; Marketan, 300m; Agno River, 3km and Caves as the least location and timing as 1km.

Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attractions in Barangay Abatan

Pakedlan has the highest mean of 4.22. Given all the evaluation areas, uses and activities and community participation ranked 5 at Vegetable Terraces, Marketan, Agno River and Pakedlan. Also, all of the tourist attractions ranked 5 in the evaluation areas on access. It is also ranked 5 in historical value for the Burial Ground, Marketan and Pakedlan. For the cultural value also it is ranked 5 in Burial Grounds and Pakedlan (See table 9).

Tourist Attraction in Barangay Loo

The tourist attraction in Barangay Loo is the Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus. This can be categorized as natural and historical attraction (See table 10).

The Loo Valley is said to be the Salad Bowl of Buguias, a production area of different vegetables, wherein BSU Buguias School Campus is found. The lotted provides and enhances quality instruction, research, extension and production by improving its



programs, developing its teachers and support staff as well as students, and improving its physical facilities.

Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attraction in Barangay Loo

The attraction has a potential market draw of daytrip, it has a socio-cultural concerns on peace and order to community life and land tenure issues. For the environmental fragility there is a possible problem on waste management and there is a high condition or renovation to work required accommodating visitors. Also the access through the location is easy.

<u>Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attraction in Barangay Loo</u>

Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus got a numerical mean which is 4.33 and got a high rank specifically on the following: cultural value, historical value, uses and activities (See table 12).

List of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Baculongan Norte

The tourist attractions in Barangay Baculongan Norte are identified as follows: The Nacgaan Spring where it is a source of clean water and the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave which is said to be the place where the recently mummies are placed. Both attractions are categorized as natural attractions. (See Table 13).

The Nacgaan Spring is found at Nacgaan. On the other hand, the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave is found at Sebseb, Baculongan Norte.



Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Baculongan Norte

The attractions have the same potential market draw which is daytrip. The Nacgaan Spring has a peace and order concern to community life while the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave has a potential disruption on socio- cultural concerns. For the environmental fragility, the Nacgaan Spring is a source of water and the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave is a nesting area for endangered species. Nacgaan Spring has a high potential use although it only has moderate ease of access while Tik-tiki Kaong Cave a medium potential use with an easy ease of access. Moreover, the attractions don't have the same distance in kilometre from the central point which is the Barangay Hall (See Table 14).

Tik-tikig Kaong Cave got the highest mean rank which is 2.89, however the rank is not as

high as the other attractions identified in the other barangay. While the Nacgaan Spring got

only 2.67 which is lower (See Table 15).

List of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Baculungan Sur

The tourist attractions in Barangay Baculungan Sur are identified as follows: the

Liyang Calatan, Tiking Agindang and Man-asok Waterfalls. The first two attractions are

categorized as cultural attraction while Man-asok Waterfalls is categorized as natural

attraction (See Table 16).

All of the attractions are found at Baculungan Sur, wherein the two attractions

which are the Liyang Calatan and Tiking Agindang are private ancestral burial grounds

and offer a background for cultural researches. The Man-asok Waterfalls is about a 4

meters high and about 2 meters wide with a strong torrent such that plans to put up electric

turbines had been considered, also it is good area for picnic area.

Assessment According to Category of Tourists Attractions in Barangay Baculungan Sur

All attractions are the same at potential market draw which is daytrip, all of them also have

the potential disruption on the socio-cultural concerns and they are also the same in

potential use which is medium. For the environmental fragility both of the cultural

attraction are nesting area for endangered species, while the Man-asok Waterfalls is a water

source. Moreover all the attractions are not the same in kilometre distance of each from the

central point which is the Barangay Hall to the site of attractions (See Table 17).

Site control refers to the area if it is largely public area to control in terms of land tenure issues (See Table 18).

Ganangan Cave and Mt. Nato-o are the tourist attractions found in Barangay Sebang. Ganangan Cave is classified as a cultural attraction while Mt. Nato-o as a natural attraction. Also Mt. Nato-o is a small mountain that is marvellous for viewing and trekking while the Ganangan Cave is a burial cave that needs further studies and exploration. (See Table 19).

Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Sebang

Ganangan Cave has a market draw of day trip. Its socio- cultural concerns and environmental fragility can be classified as land tenure issues and possible problem on waste management respectively. Ganangan Cave can be visited from the central point at anytime. However, it only has medium potential use.

On the other hand, Mt. Nato- o, a natural attraction of Barangay Sebang, has a market draw of day trip. It has potential disruption as its socio- cultural concerns. The natural attraction has an environmental fragility of water source. It has high ease of access although it only has moderate ease of access and its distance from the central point is 5km (See Table 20).

Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attractions in Barangay Sebang

Mt. Nato- o has a higher computed mean of 3.67 than Ganangan Cave with a computed mean of only 3. 22. As presented in Table 7.2, the computed means of each tourist attraction was very close. It also has a very little difference in the ratings of each inventory evaluation (See Table 21).

List of Tourist Attractions In Barangay Catlubong

The tourist attractions in Barangay Catlubong are identified as follows: Mt. Pulag Jr. and Pay-as fall. All of them are found at Ponopon and are categorized as natural. Mt. Pulag Jr. is a mountain close to the much higher Mt. Pulag, it also offers exciting trekking, camping and picnic sites while the Pay-as Falls is said to be a twin falls because the source of its water came from two distinct locations, and it is about 10 meters high.

List of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Poblacion

The tourist attractions in Barangay Poblacion are identified as follows: Abbao. Swimming Pool, Botel Swimming Pool, Non- Salty Hot Spring, Rice Terraces, Salty Hot Spring, Small Waterfall, and Vegetable Terraces. The first two attractions are categorized as recreational while the Rice Terraces and Vegetable Terraces are categorized as cultural. On the other hand, Non- Salty Hot Spring, Salty Hot Spring and the Capuyoan Waterfall are regarded as natural (See Table 25).

The Abbao Swimming Pool is found in Abbao and the Botel Swimming Pool is found in Botel. Both are manmade swimming pools and are private resorts. The Non-Salty Hot Spring can be found in Demang, and Rice Terraces is found in Ampetang. The Salty Hot Spring is found in Kapangngan / Poblacion, the Small Waterfall in Capuyoan and the Vegetable Terraces covers the whole barangay of Poblacion. Both the hot springs offer possibilities for natural hot bath in constructed bath houses. These attractions are close to each other except for the Capuyoan Falls which is about 1.6 kilometers away from central point and it is just a small falls having a height of about 3 meters



Assessment According to Category of Tourist Attractions in Barangay Poblacion

For the cultural attractions, both attractions have the potential market draw of day trip. Both cultural attractions also have the same socio-cultural concerns and environmental fragility of land tenure issues and possible problem on waste management respectively. Also their potential use, location and timing are the same.

For the natural attractions of Barangay Poblacion, it has all the same market draw, socio-cultural concerns, environmental fragility, and potential use which is day trip, potential disruption, water source high and easy respectively. But they have different distance of location from the central point. Non-Salty Hot Spring has a 1.5 km distance from the central point, Salty Hot Spring has 300m and Small Waterfall has 1.6 km.

Moreover, the recreational attractions also has the same market draw, sociocultural concerns and environmental fragility which is day trip, peace and order community life and possible problem on waste management respectively. Also, both recreational attractions have the same level of difficulty which is medium. Swimming is also best activity to take place on the recreational attractions in Barangay Poblacion (See Table 26).

<u>Inventory Evaluation Sheet of Attractions in Barangay Poblacion</u>

Abbao Swimming Pool and Botel Swimming Pool both garnered the highest computed mean of 4.33. Both attractions were ranked 5 in scenic value, uses and activities, community participation, site control and product development. Meanwhile, all the tourist attractions in Barangay Poblacion were ranked 5 in scenic value. On the other hand, the Rice Terraces of Baranagy poblacion garnered the lowest computed mean of 2.78 (See Table 27).

Summary List Of Tourist Attraction By The Mean Rank Given By Key Informants

All the ranked tourist attractions were further evaluated by the Mayor, Vice Mayor, DOT Official and the ABC Captain of Buguias. The inventory evaluation sheet comprises of the scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities, community participation, site control, access and product development. Each of these is



ranked from 1-5, wherein 5 is the highest positive ranking and 1 is the lowest ranking. Table 29 summarizes the total mean ratings made by these key informants for all the tourist attractions. Only the top five tourist attractions were chosen for the assessment of infrastructure and services available in the area.

Rank Inventory Evaluation Sheet of the top 5 Tourist Attractions

From this table, the top 5 tourist attractions are: Botel Swimming Pool, Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus, Abbao Swimming Pool, Apo Anno Cave and Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces. While the others are still not validated and explored.

The following section elaborates on the specific assessments made by the key informants for the top 5 tourist attractions:

Rank 1. Botel Swimming Pool

The result shows that Botel Swimming Pool has the first top highest total mean rank in all of the tourist attraction which is 19.44 and has a very high interpretation in all of the evaluation areas. More specifically high in ranking on the scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities (See Table 30).

Rank 2. Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus

The result shows that Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus has the second top highest total mean rank in all tourist attraction which is 19.44 and has a very high interpretation in all of the evaluation areas. More specifically high in ranking of the scenic value, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities (See Table 31).

Rank 3. Abbao Swimming Pool



The result shows that Abbao Swimming Pool has the third top highest total mean rank in all tourist attraction which is 19.22 and has a very high interpretation in all of the evaluation areas. More specifically high in ranking on the scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value and historical value (See Table 32).

Rank 4. Apo Anno Cave

The result shows that Apo Anno Cave has the fourth top highest total mean rank in all tourist attraction which is 18.89 and has a very high interpretation in all evaluation areas. More specifically high in ranking on the scenic value, cultural value, historical value, access and product development (See Table 33).

Rank 5. Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces

The result shows that the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces has the fifth top highest total mean rank in all tourist attraction which is 18.67 and has a very high interpretation in all evaluation areas except for the product development. More specifically high in ranking on the scenic value, biodiversity, cultural value, historical value, uses and activities (See Table 34).

From the top 5 tourist attraction their infrastructure and services available were voted by the Barangay Officials. It comprises the transportation sheet, public services and evaluation surroundings of the top 5 tourist attractions. LGU's Plan and Development Program

For the LGU's plan and development programs for each of the top 5 attractions are: to construct waiting sheds, electric lights, cell site, and police outpost for the top 1 and 3 attraction which is the Botel swimming pool and Abbao swimming pool. While for the top 4 and 5 attraction which are the Apo Anno Cave and Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces are to developed the tourist attractions potentially and to make some funding on construction of public toilets and rehabilitation of site and roads to the area. Also for the top 2 attraction which is the Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias school campus, is that the concerned Barangay is about to make some improvements and beautification of the tourist attraction.



SUMMARY, CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Summary

This study was conducted to assess the tourist attractions in each of the Barangays of Buguias, to assess the infrastructure and services available in the area, and lastly to determine the LGU plan and development programs that will benefit the tourists attractions, tourists and the people of the community.

There were 20 respondents in this study namely: the Municipal officials and Barangay officials of the area. A survey questionnaire, observation through transect walk and interview schedules were used in the collection of data. The framework followed by the Tourism Assessment made by Gutierrez *et al.* (2005). The data was analyzed using simple statistics, ranking and descriptive.

The results of the study showed that the Municipality of Buguias has a number of tourist attractions found in the various Barangays as follows: the Apo Anno Cave, Crocodile Head, Dugen Cave, Cuyapon Falls and the Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces in Barangay Natubleng; the Organic Agricultural Learning Center and the Sabeng Anito Conservation park in Barangay Lengaoan; the Agno river, Burial Grounds, Cave, Garden Terraces, Marketan and the Pakedlan in Barangay Abatan; the BSU School Campus and the whole Barangay of Loo which is claimed to be the salad bowl of Buguias in Barangay Loo; the Nacgaan Spring and the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave in Barangay Baculungan Norte; the Liyang Calatan, Man-asok Waterfalls and the Tiking Agindang in Barangay Baculungan Sur; the Ganangan Cave and Mt. Nato-o in Barangay Sebang; the Mt. Pulag Jr. and the Pay-as Falls in Barangay Catlubong; And the Abbao Swimming Pool, Botel Swimming Pool, Non-salty Hot Spring, Rice Terraces, Salty Hot Spring, Small



Waterfall and the Vegetable Garden in Barangay Poblacion. The following attractions were identified as natural: the Crocodile Head, Cuyapon Falls, Sabeng Anito Conservation Park, Agno River, Caves, Loo Valley, Nacgaan Spring, Tigfigang Kaong Cave, Man-Asok Waterfalls, Mt. Nato-O, Mt. Pulag Jr., Pay-As Falls Non-Salty Hot Spring, Salty Hot Spring and Capuyoan Falls. The following are cultural attractions: Apo Anno cave, Dugen Cave, Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces, Organic Vegetable Learning Center, Burial Grounds, Vegetable Terraces in Abatan, Pakedlan, Liyang Calatan, Tiking Agindang, Ganangan Cave, Rice Terraces and Vegetable Terraces in Poblacion. While for the Abbao and Botel Swimming Pool are both recreational but for the Marketan in Abatan is historical. All attractions were assessed as follows: the nearest tourist attraction to its barangay center is Salty Hot Spring and the farthest is the Pay-as Falls. The following tourist attractions were assessed to have ease of access for the Tik-tiki Kaong Cave, Manasok Waterfalls, Non-salty Hot Spring, Salty Hot Spring and Capuyoan Falls. High potential use was identified for Apo Anno Cave, Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces, Cuyapon Falls, Organic Agricultural Center, Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus, Nacgaan Spring, Mt. Nato-o, Non-salty Hot spring, Salty Hot Spring and Capuyoan Waterfalls. The common environmental concerns are the possibility of problems on waste management and water source. For the socio-cultural concerns are the potential disruption, peace and order to community life. All the tourist attractions have a market draw of day trip. The top ten ranked tourist attraction by the barangay based on the inventory evaluation are as follows: the Organic Agriculutural Learning Center, Abbao Swimming Pool, Botel Swimming Pool, Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus, Pakedlan, Tiking Agindang, Liyang Calatan, Agno River, Apo Anno Cave, Man-



asok Waterfalls and Non-salty Hot Spring. On the other hand the top five tourist attractions ranked by the key informants are the: Botel Swimming Pool, Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias School Campus, Abbao Swimming Pool, Apo Anno Cave and Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces. The infrastructure and services available are largely available except for the ambulance service, fire protection service and local banking services in the top five tourist attractions. The LGU plans and development programs include the construction of waiting sheds, electric lights, cell site, and police outpost for the top 1 and 3 attraction which is the Botel swimming pool and Abbao swimming pool. While for the top 4 and 5 attraction which are the Apo Anno Cave and Natubleng Apanberang Vegetable Terraces are to developed the tourist attractions potentially and to make some funding on construction of public toilets and rehabilitation of site and roads to the area. Also for the top 2 attraction which is the Loo Valley with the BSU Buguias school campus, is that the concerned Barangay is about to make some improvements and beautification of the tourist attraction.

Conclusions

Based on the results of the study, the following can be concluded:

- 1. The municipality of Buguias can boast of a number of tourists attractions which has a great potential for employment and economic benefit.
- 2. The tourist attractions are categorized as cultural, natural, historical and recreational. But not all of the tourist attraction have been validated and discovered. There is a need for further exploration of it by the concerned authorities.
- 3. Most infrastructure and services are available, except for the following: ambulance service, fire protection service, and local banking services.



4. The tourist attractions are needing further product development, increased uses and activities, greater community participation, and better site control and access.

Recommendations

- 1. The municipality of Buguias should promote tourism especially for the identified tourist attractions in this study. It is suggested that the local government should do further exploration of this sites. Since there are still tourists attractions that are not validated and still not discovered.
- 2. The local government of Buguias should provide direct attention on the following:
- a. The attractions identified should be improved and renovated such as making the pathways to the site safe for the tourist, and should be maintained and preserved.
- b. Government funding should be allocated to construct facilities that will be needed to boost the tourism in the identified attractions.
- 3. Development of brochures and websites to further promote the various tourist attractions. The local government should come up with a promotional package for the tourists.



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
